ASSEMBLY

Review the manual and bring your cordless drill. Typically, two adults can transform your space into a fully functioning sauna in a few hours. Ensure the sauna is placed on a level, hard waterproof surface. Saunas are freestanding and can be disassembled and moved at any time.

SHIPPING

Saunas ship via truck and arrive curbside on a single pallet. Please note that shipping weight is approximately 715 pounds.

SHIPPING POLICY

On the day your sauna ships, you will receive an email notification that will provide the carrier and tracking number. The carrier will call you when the shipment arrives in your region to set up a delivery appointment. If you are away and unable to receive the delivery, we recommend you plan for someone to accept the delivery.

UPON ARRIVAL

The freight charge includes delivery curbside to your home; the carrier will offload your order with a lift-gate to the curb at the end of your driveway (this excludes cabin saunas and larger barrel saunas).

Examine the exterior of the shipment. The sauna will be packaged, wrapped, and banded on a single pallet and can be maneuvered with the aid of a pallet jack. The pallet can also be disassembled, and each item moved individually. We recommend you have at least two individuals available to accept delivery.

In the rare instance, the carrier determines that delivery cannot be made due to isolation or other specifics of your location, you may pursue other options.

Option 1

A smaller delivery truck can be arranged through a third-party carrier. ThermaSol will do its best to make these arrangements if logistically possible, but you will be responsible for any added costs if they are incurred.

Option 2

Saunas can be picked up at the local terminal. Most saunas can fit onto a pickup truck or small trailer, and the travel time to the terminal is typically between 1-2 hours. If the customer refuses the sauna delivery without pursuing the options listed above, the customer will be held responsible for the return shipping costs and any related costs. Likewise, any re-delivery or storage fees incurred will be charged to the customer.

PROPER SAUNA CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Saunas should be kept clean and odor free
- When not in use, leaving the door & vents open allows the sauna to “breathe”
- Bathers should always sit on a towel; otherwise, perspiration will penetrate the softwood

Every Few Weeks

- Wipe the benches with a damp cloth, and use warm water when necessary
- Vacuum the interior
- Clean glass always enhances the saunas appeal

Annually

- Remove the stones from the heater cavity, and check for any cracks. Replace stones as needed.
- Use a hand vacuum on the heater cavity to remove dust, debris, or small chipped stones.
- Rinse the sauna stones, and thoroughly dry them before returning them to the heater cavity.
- Use fine-grit sandpaper on any tough bench stains.
