Water District Calendar Year 2012 Report: The Bridgton Water District has provided their annual Consumer confidence Report for the calendar year ending December 31, 2012. You may contact Ms. Kelly Johnson at the District Office- 647-2881 for more information about the results of the water supply. In general, the system water was considered to have very small amounts of some contaminants which may not pose any health risk.

General Revenue Sharing: Despite the larger amount of revenue received last month, the month of July receipts were about half or \$14,347. This is expected to fluctuate over the next several months. However, we are monitoring this to determine if we might come up short at the end of the year.

Successful Folk Festival: Our congratulations to the organizers, volunteers and all the participants who pulled together a great Folk Festival on Depot Street last weekend, August 17th. Once again motivated people pulled together to make Bridgton Shine. We hope the festival will continue in coming years and that more of our community and visitors will participate.

New Electronic Voting Recorder: We invite our voters to try out the new voting recorder that will tally all ballot votes at any elections. It is in our front lobby and is very easy to use.

Audit Request for Proposals: The Town will be issuing an RFP for Auditing of its accounting and finances with a request to have the participating firms return their proposals no later than September 17, 2013. We will be looking for a three (3) term with the possibility of an additional three (3) years depending of the quality of the auditing procedures that the Town experiences. I will be sending the RFP out towards the end of August.

Meet and Greet: The Town in collaboration with the Bridgton Community Center will host a joint Meet N' Greet for the public to meet Gary Colella, our Recreation Director. The September 18th event will take place at the Community Center which will include activities as well as refreshments. We encourage the Board and the public to attend.
