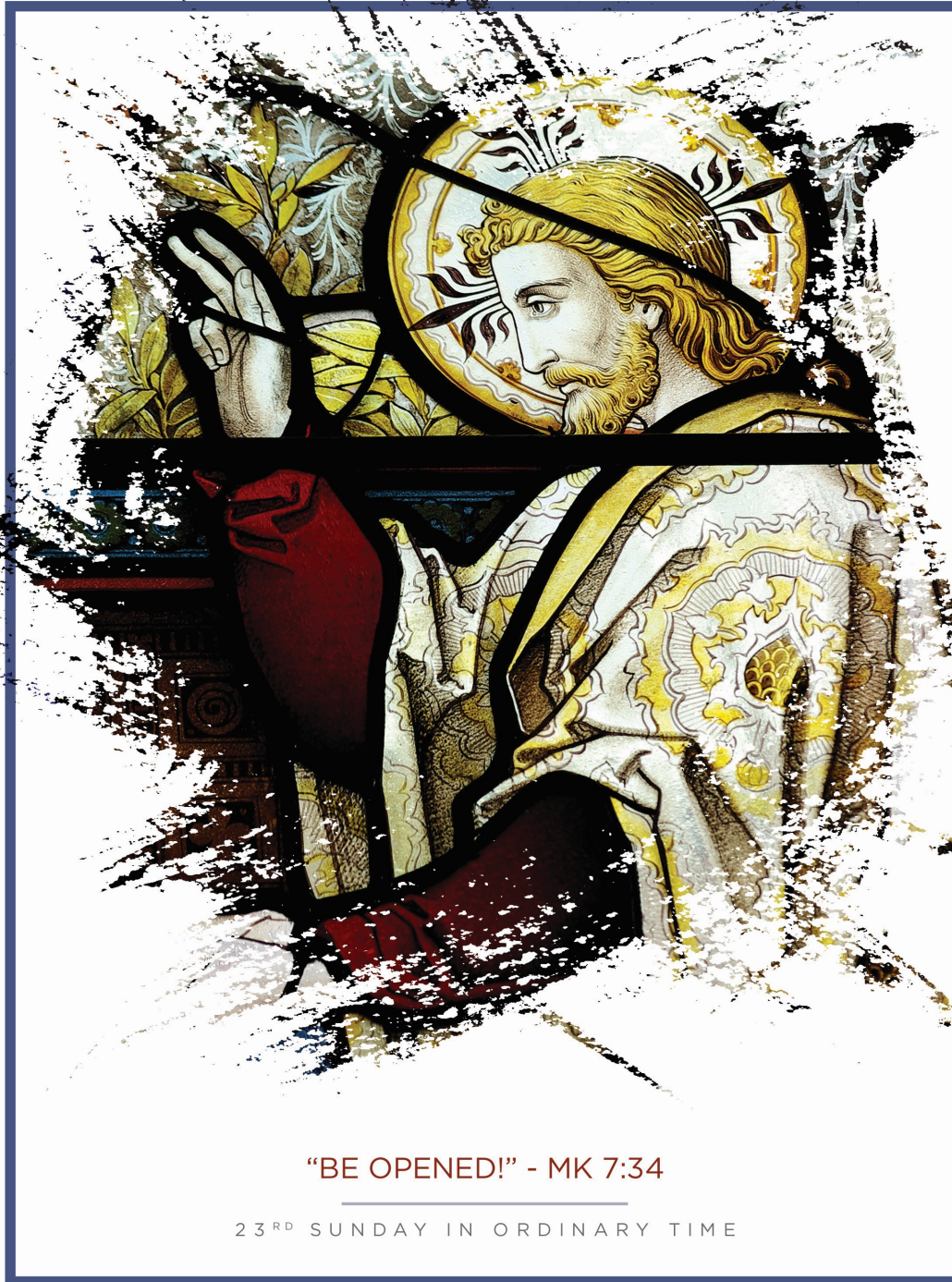

Safe Environment:

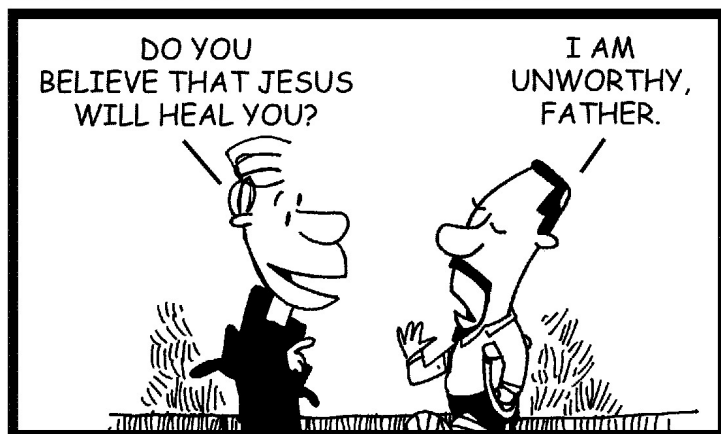
