**Thank you** for your support of the *Pastor's Discretionary Fund*. Throughout the year people within our church and community come to our church seeking financial assistance for personal emergencies. Contributions to this fund allow the church to meet these requests for rent assistance, electric bills, medications, etc., as they deem necessary.

As of this year, through June 10, we have assisted 61 families with \$4,582.75 for utilities and 24 families (\$25 voucher each) for a total of \$600 in Kerosene vouchers—vouchers are given during the winter months. This fund is all but depleted because of the increase in demand from higher utility bills as-well-as the need for secondary heating (K-1 vouchers).
