2 Cans un-drained tuna
2 Eggs
1 1/2 C Flour (I use whole wheat)
1/4 C Parmesan cheese
Sprinkle of garlic powder (not salt) if desired
Mix together in a greased (with good oil) 9 x 9 pan
Bake a 350 degrees for 20 minutes


"Phoebe"
