Edward Kobylski, age 78 of Caseville, passed away Wednesday, April 16 at his home following a long illness.

He was born in Hamtramck on August 28, 1918, the son of the late Walter and Agnes (Klein) Kobylski. On September 1, 1945 he was united in marriage to Clarabelle Robinson in Detroit. She survives him.
