

Closing the Library Due to Weather Conditions

Sherrard Public Library District will make every effort to offer service to the community in spite of weather conditions by maintaining regular service hours.

If weather conditions are extreme, the Library can be closed at the discretion of the Director. Extreme cold or heat, high wind, or conditions in the Library building are examples of reasons the Director might choose to announce the closing of the Library.

The Director will announce the closing of the Library by contacting as many local television stations as possible and by posting the closing on the Library website so that the members of the community will be aware of the closing. The call letters of the television stations will be posted in the Library, listed in the newsletter, and appear on the website.
