CHS Marching Band students are divided into (3) different assignments:

- 1. Varsity (Grades 9 12) Highest ranking band students from auditions. Students that display the best physical coordination with the ability to move and play as needed. Students with the highest level of commitment to excellence. Students that have no school sponsored conflicts with the band schedule.
- 2. J.V. (Grades 9 12) Moderately ranked band students from auditions. Students that display a developing physical coordination that shows promise to be able to perform a varsity level show with more practice. JV students are considered "under-studies" in the varsity show and could be placed into a varsity position at any time.
- 3. Cadet (Grades 9 12) Cadet students typically need more time to develop playing skills, physical coordination, or may have another competitive school sponsored varsity activity that prohibits participation in band at a Varsity level.

Regardless of level of assignment, <u>all students are a part of the CHS Marching Band</u> and will have an opportunity to perform with the band at assigned halftime shows, pep rallies, and parades. Only varsity students will perform at marching band contests and at specific district football games where the contest show is scheduled to be performed exclusively.
