- 1. All classes must be representative of breed.
- 2. Fulton County Bred and Owned classes are limited to animals that originated on a farm/ranch within the geographical area of Fulton County. Fulton County Born and Raised classes are for animals that was born on the exhibitor's farm and raised there. Exhibitors cannot enter the Bred and Owned Classes if they enter the Born and Raised Classes. All animals in the Bred and Owned classes must have an "Assurance of Origin" on file in the fair office by check-in date (July 28, 2021), and must meet exhibition health requirements. Exhibitors cannot enter both Animals must be owned by the exhibitor and the exhibitors must be residents of Fulton County or attend school in Fulton County.
- 3. Premiums will be paid on 1st through 6th places as follows: 1st-40 points, 2nd-35 points, 3rd-30 points, 4th-25 points; 5th-20 points, and 6th-15 points. Rosettes will be awarded to the Grand Champion Male and Female and the Reserve Champion Male and Female by breed. No points will be awarded for rosettes.

Out of county exhibitors and adult exhibitors must use Divisions 310 and 311.
