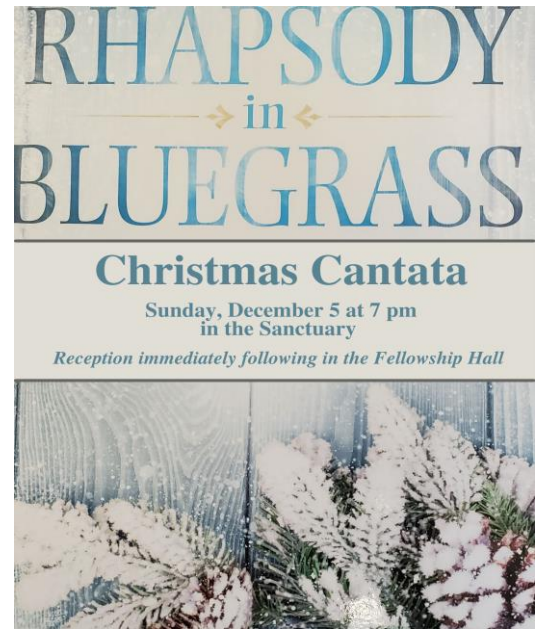
Food Pantry
