## HULL, KEEL

Light weight hull built using a sandwich technology. Lifting keel and rudder blades

Hull, deck and internal structures are built in vinylester resin and glass in vacuum bagged infusion technology and sandwich construction with PVC foam.

The boat has a lifting keel with lead bulb and two lifting rudder blades with a custom steering system and two steering wheels, that guarantee perfect position and control to the helmsman and allow free crew movement in every racing situation as well as when relaxing in the XL cockpit.

Antiskid Deck

1 fore hatch with in-built drains

2 non-opening port lights on the sides of the hull

2 opening port lights on cockpit walls

Anchor and anchor line box on fore-deck

Open self-draining cockpit with a large storage locker

Swimming ladder and shower on the aft

The boat has a lifting keel with lead bulb and two lifting rudder blades with a custom steering lines drive system. The boat has two steering wheels with a large passage way between them.
