**Overall High Mileage Rider** is based on the mileage completed by one rider riding any number of equines.

**Overall High Mileage Horse** is based on the mileage completed by one equine with any number of riders.

The following awards are based on the mileage completed by one rider riding one equine:

- High Mileage Featherweight**
- High Mileage Lightweight**
- High Mileage Middleweight**
- High Mileage Heavyweight**
- High Mileage Junior**

**High Mileage Husband/Wife** award is given to the couple with the most combined mileage ridden.

Safe, well-marked trail; superior organization—camp, registration, P/R and vet checks, availability of professional emergency personnel and equipment,

Cumulative lifetime achievement. Perhaps has overcome adversity and continued on. The horse people remember and talk about.

## TERA BOARD MEETING, Saturday, May 24, 2008

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m.
2. Present: Dianne Campbell, Ann Goolsby, Carol Kight, Dawn Carrie, Proxy given by Kim Reeves to Dianne Campbell  
Guests Present: Ross Carrie, Michael Campbell, Bo and Linda Parrish
3. Minutes: Minutes of the last Board meeting were reviewed and accepted.
4. Treasurer's Report: Carol did not have a formal Treasurer's Report to give. She stated there is a little over \$6,000 in the current account.
5. Old Business: Carol will give a brief report on the final results of the Arranged Ties voting to the membership tonight.
6. New Business:
  - A. Liability Insurance from Equisure  
All Board members had previously reviewed the two policies from Equisure. The premium on the Directors & Officers policy is \$638.00 per year. The premium on the

Club general liability policy is \$782.18. The vote was unanimous to approve both of these insurances. Bo and Linda Parrish expressed their agreement with this decision. The insurance situation will be reviewed in one year to see if it continues to be financially feasible.

- B. Central Region Championship Ride  
The Board had previously approved a \$300 contribution for this year's ride. The belt buckles that have been ordered as Top Ten prizes will cover at least three years. The Board voted to give \$600 now as it's contribution for 2008 and 2009. This amount will go toward the cost of the belt buckles.
  - C. Ride Manager's Clinic  
Ann Goolsby will speak with the membership on this year's Ride Manager's Clinic.
  - D. Old Glory 2009  
Both Vicki Holzer and Eron Howell have expressed an interest in managing Old Glory for 2009. The site and date have yet to be determined. Memorial Day weekend will not be used next year due to the Central Region Championship being held at the Jo Tate ride the same weekend.
