



SA Volleyball- 2018

All matches will begin at 3:30 unless other arrangements have been made between competing schools. Winning teams will be determined by the best of 3 games format. Rally scoring will be used with the first two games going to 25 and the third game, if necessary, going to 15. A regulation game ball should be used. **A line 6' in front of the normal service line can be used by the JV players to serve.** Leniency will be shown if a player crosses the middle court line but does not interfere with another player. **The height of the net should be 7'4"**. All other rules of volleyball will be enforced with an emphasis **on illegal carries**, substitutions, and attacking serves. All host sites are responsible for having at least one certified official.
