PROGRAM: Terracon Consultants, Inc. "Terra - Who?"

Presented by: Kristen Uecker

Terracon Consultants, Inc. is a multi-discipline firm specializing in environmental, facilities, geotechnical and material services.

Kristen Uecker has been with Terracon for over 20 years, is a Senior Administration Assistant and also serves as the Corporate Services Representative for the Fargo office. Uecker is a graduate of Concordia College, married to Shannon, they have three daughters and live in Fargo.



PROGRAM: "Drones in Civil Engineering - Now What?"

Presented by: Chad Qualley, of Houston Engineering, inc. (HEI)

Chad will be discussing the use of drone technology (aerial or small UAS) in Civil Engineering. He will outline the process of becoming a certified pilot with the FAA, what equipment is needed to fly, and what software is used to capture and process the data once it is complete. HEI uses drones for Hydro bathymetry or a remotely operated vehicle to get depths in bodies of water. This technique is a significant improvement over conventional survey, reducing effort and time. Chad will provide a demonstration using the data that is acquired from Drones in Civil 3d and ArcGIS software suites and will highlight examples where Drone technology has improved projects by including more data for decision making.

Chad Qualley is the CAD Manager / Survey Technical Coordinator for Houston Engineering. Certified sUAS remote pilot. He oversees implementation and rollouts for all Autodesk software including establishing and maintaining company CAD standards. Is a senior designer working on site grading, road and rail designs and all things survey. Chad has 18 years experience in the civil engineering field and has used Autodesk Civil 3D since it first appeared in 2004.
