A RESOLUTION

Authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Fostoria, Ohio, to file an application with the Seneca County Park District to participate in the 2020 Community Parks Grant Program, and declaring an emergency to exist.

WHEREAS, the Seneca County Park District provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of addressing local park needs; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fostoria, Ohio desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance from the Seneca County Park District Community Parks Improvement Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fostoria, Ohio directs, authorizes and empowers the Mayor to act in connection with the grant program and to provide such information as may be required, to apply for and contract said grants on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Seneca County, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Fostoria, Ohio authorizes, directs and empowers the Mayor as the official representative of the City of Fostoria, Ohio to participate in the Seneca County Park District 2020 Community Parks Improvement Grant Program and provide all information and documentation required in said Application, to execute any agreements and applications, and to enter into contract on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. The project that the Council of the City of Fostoria, Ohio hereby approves for filing an application shall be for new grills, soccer fields, brick façade repair and gutters on dug outs.

SECTION 3. That the Council of the City of Fostoria, Ohio hereby understands and agrees that participation in the Program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

AN ORDINANCE

Establishing the City of Fostoria's Coronavirus Relief Fund, (252), and declaring an emergency to exist.

WHEREAS, R. C. 5705.09 (F) authorizes a taxing authority to establish certain funds for a class of revenues derived from a source other than the general property tax, which funds are to be used for a particular purpose.

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in Senate Bill 310 of the 133rd General Assembly (S.B. 310); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fostoria is requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fostoria must establish a fund for said moneys from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Hancock, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the new Coronavirus Relief Fund (252) be, and the same is hereby, established by and for the City of Fostoria pursuant to R. C. 5705.09 (F) to receive and account for all moneys received by the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund and held by the City of Fostoria.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 731.21 and 731.22.


SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal

requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Fostoria and its inhabitants, and in order to establish this new fund so that moneys being received may be appropriately accounted for without delay, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance.




