

Mission Statement



First Day Procedures

- ♦ The First Day of School is Thursday, September 8th
- Please arrive through the school yard entrance between
 7:30 am 8:00 am
- Breakfast is served daily in the student cafeteria from 7:30 am - 8:00 am. Advisory begins at 8:00 am
- Staff will be on hand with class rosters ready to direct students to their classes
- ♦ Sixth grade student lunch is from 11:19 am 12:02 pm. Sixth graders have their own lunch period and do not share the cafeteria with other grades
- Students will be dismissed at 2:20 pm. Sixth grade students are dismissed in the front of the building on East 68th Street.
- The following MTA busses are available at dismissal in the front of the building daily: B41, B46, & B47.



1. Students will enter the building through Exit D in the back of the building

 Breakfast will be provided in the Cafeteria from 7:30 am – 8:00 am.
 Student may play in the school yard or have breakfast in the morning

3. When there is inclement weather we will utilize holding areas if needed from 7:30 am – 8:00 am. The Grade 6 holding area is the student Cafeteria

4. On the First Two Days of School (September 13th & 14) we will open our entry doors at 7:30 am and grade 6 students will report to the Cafeteria in order to meet their teachers by class

- Student programs are by class with the exception of Minor Track Classes and SEM
- ♦ Student programs vary by day of the week






