### Behavior Policy

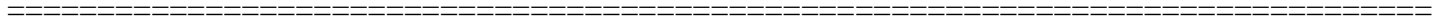
#### Consequences for Inappropriate Behavior

- First Time: A warning will be given to the youth by the teacher(s).
- Second Time: The parent will be called. The DRE and Father will be notified.
- Third Time: Removal of youth from the class. The parent will be called. The youth will be kept after class to make-up the class time missed. A meeting will be held with the youth, parents, teacher(s), DREs and Father before the youth will be allowed to attend class again.

Parents are more than welcome to attend a class with their youth to observe the weekly lesson/activity.

If inappropriate behavior is found to be a problem for an entire class, parents of the youth in that class will be asked to attend the weekly class with their youth.
