### **REGULAR SESSION**

### **REGIONAL PLANNING REPORT:**

Speakers present promoting Fairfield County and conducting tours around the county.

### **ZONING:**

Inspector Marshall reported 32 permits YTD. One accessory building for the month on 5902 Windy Hills Circle for a shed. One lot split 2575 Lancaster Circleville Road. The fence is acceptable at the Becks Knob Road Auto Repair Shop.

### **CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE FISCAL OFFICER:**

Minutes from the August Meeting being read prior by the Board were approved as read, so moved by Trustee Claypool and seconded by Trustee Ellinger. All were in favor with 3 ayes and no negative votes, motion passed. Still working on having the EMS unit posted on Govdeals.

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### **FIRE DEPARTMENT:**

Monthly runs so far have been 8 fire and 21 EMS for a total of 462 YTD. There were a total of 8 mutual aids provided to Amanda, Lancaster, and Berne, townships. A total of \$1,427.58 was received from the Aladdin Shriners for a grant.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

1. The property of Jon and Cathy Born is being worked on with Fairfield County Soil and Water.
2. Trustee Claypool motioned to utilize Jhermy Bigham for the project on Hopewell Church Rd. and not to exceed \$3500.00. Trustee Ellinger seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.
3. Trustee Wolfe motioned to utilize Jheremy Bigham for the Boice Road project and not to exceed \$1,303.00. Trustee Ellinger seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.
4. Squad will be posted on Govdeals.com and the Hocking web page
5. Mid Ohio was the winning bidder for the tree removal on several roads within the township.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Trustees need to look for an area to have an OPWC project completed. The grant application is due in 2019. We will use the county force account fund to help fund this project.
2. We received a variance application received for Mary Reedy for the property located at 2575 Lancaster Circleville Road for a lot split.
3. Dixie Smith is willing to serve as the secretary for the both zoning boards. Trustee Ellinger motioned to accept and appoint Dixie Smith as the Secretary of the Zoning Commission Board and Zoning Appeals Board. Trustee Claypool seconded the motion.

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All were in favor with 3 ayes and no negative votes, motion passed. The Trustees thanked her.

Trustee Claypool moved to pay the warrants for the month seconded by Trustee Ellinger. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.

There being no further business to discuss Trustee Wolfe motioned to adjourn and Trustee Claypool seconded the motion.

  
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
