OCIA is a process open to adults who are unbaptized, were raised in another religious tradition or were baptized Catholic as an infant or as a small child, but did not participate in religious education and have not received their First Communion. Priest Appreciation Day October 13, 2024




On Sunday, **October 13th** we celebrate Priest Appreciation Day! It is a time to honor those who are priests, especially our priest, Father Ernest.
