The **Huron Township Rotary** believes the education opportunities that students seek deserve support.

Each year the Huron Township Rotary offers opportunities for students to assess their needs, and apply for one of several scholarships.

- The **Virginia Bird Academic Scholarships** are in honor and memory of the wife of one of our Rotary members, awarded to a male and female graduating senior from Huron High School in the amount of \$1000.00 each.
- The **Al Gessert Fine and Performing Arts Memorial Scholarship** will be awarded to a student who is an active participant in the fine or performing arts, in the amount of \$1000.00
- The **James "Hammer" Mason Vocational Scholarship** is in honor of, and represents the vocational arts, in the amount of \$1000.00.
- The **Arte Stoner Scholarship**, is in honor of Mrs. Stoner and represents academic and athletic performance, in the amount of \$1000.00.
- The **Sheila K. Williams Community Service Scholarship** will be awarded to the applicant who has demonstrated *Service Above Self*, and is in the amount of \$1000.00.
- The **Steve Chont Agriscience/Environmental Scholarship** is in honor of and represents students who exhibit a promising future in environmental improvement and leadership or agricultural education, in the amount of \$1000.00.
- Secondary scholarships are given at a value of \$500.00 each. Applicants for these scholarships should demonstrate both a scholastic aptitude and a financial need.

All applicants should provide all the information requested on the application obtained through the high school counseling office. In addition, a well-written, word processed and thorough essay should be returned with that application along with a transcript of the grades earned (both HS and college classes if available). The HT Rotary Scholarship committee will review all applications and essays and invite eleven students to interview at a dinner / interview evening, on **Tuesday, May 10, 2022, at 6:30 PM**, held at the Willow United Methodist Church on Willow Road. *As a note of explanation:* filing an application is not an invitation to the dinner / interview. Important criteria on the application includes the household combined income as well as your active and documented participation in community service opportunities. In addition, it is important and necessary that if you are invited that you attend the dinner / interview on **Tuesday, May 10; applicants for the interview will be notified at Huron High School on Monday, May 2.** You will need to RSVP to an eMail address that will be provided with your invitation to the dinner / interview.

- Scholarships will be awarded at the HHS Awards & Recognitions Night, **Tuesday, May 17, 2022.**

Within the essay, the committee would appreciate that you include your past experience in the community, i.e., service projects (such as Outdoor Challenge, Meals on Wheels, the volunteer program, tutoring, etc.), and that you highlight your long-term goals. Please do not assume that some of the service that you may have done in relation to Rotary projects will be remembered: take this opportunity to mention it again.
