- Sixth: Reports from Committees  
Councilman Lemora Moses reported that he asked Northwest Cemetery Committee Member Ms. Ruth Burch about using the \$8,000.00 budgeted amount for Cemetery Expense to be donated to repairing the grave slabs.  
Councilman Moses stated that Mr. Aldene Tyson would charge \$300.00 per grave repair. Councilman Moses asked Community Development Consultant Earl Denham to research grants for cemetery improvements.
- Ninth: Mayor Matt Seale called for a motion to adjourn the meeting.
