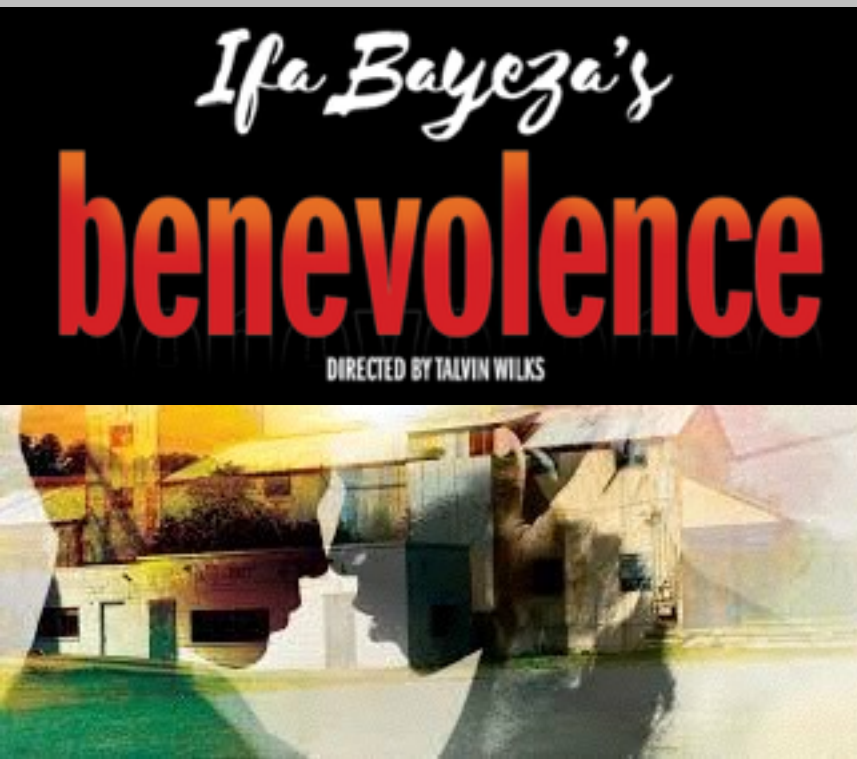


# Northwest Suburban Integration School District
