WHAT TO PARK WHERE

Architecture Guidelines - Driveways and Parking of Vehicles

There have been an increasing number of boats, trailers and inoperable vehicles being parked in driveways and on our neighborhood streets. This topic is covered in our Architectural Guidelines under:


II-Architectural Standards

K. Driveways and Parking of Vehicles

- 2. Permanent or temporary (other than overnight) parking or storage of motor homes, mobile homes, trailers, boats, commercial vehicles, e.g., buses, taxi cabs, vans, or trucks with commercial logos and related equipment outside the garage or house of any Owner is not permitted. Parking, storage, or driving on the common areas, including the pipeline easement, is not permitted. These prohibited vehicles may be stored in an Owner's garage, provided the garage door is regularly kept closed. Per Fairfax County code, parking on grass is prohibited.
- 3. Vehicles parked on the driveway must be in running order. Vehicles which are being worked on shall be worked on in the garage or if in the driveway, shall be stationary no more than 72 hours. This in no way precludes residents from using their driveways for routine maintenance and minor repair of their vehicles. Vehicles which are not currently registered and State inspected are considered inoperative.

In a spirit of cooperation with our homeowners, the ARC and Board have been cognizant of the fact that many residents enjoy using their seasonal equipment during the summer months. We have sent friendly reminders to residents requesting that they abide by the rules of the association. Several residents responded by relocating and properly storing their equipment but many have not. Now that we are well past the summer months, it's only fair and proper that all residents adhere to the guidelines and regulations. Some of these vehicles are not only unsightly, but where they are parked is creating visual obstructions for drivers and presenting safety issues as the days get shorter and daylight hours wane. This topic was brought forth for the second time by a resident in the "Homeowner Open Forum" during our October Board meeting.

Our Architectural Guidelines were updated and revised in July of 2014 to include current county ordinances and feedback from our residents. The ARC Committee is asking, via this article, if you are the owner of any of these vehicles or are parking in contrast to our guidelines, that you remedy the situation as a courtesy and respect for your neighbors.








PERFECT TIME TO "TRIM YOUR TREES"
