


Wednesday Night Study Begins September 12

A new Wednesday night study will begin on September 12. This 5-week study is titled Grace/Truth 1.0 and will be led by Pastor Erik. Grace/Truth 1.0 is a five week small group study that introduces Christians to LGBT+ people, the language to use and avoid, a theologically faithful view of marriage and sexuality, and practical guidance on how to embody the love of Christ toward sexual and gender minorities.

Each week of Grace/Truth 1.0 is accompanied with a number of questions designed to facilitate small group discussions where Christians can engage the material in thoughtful ways.

Prayer Service


