






Our Plan to Return to In-Person Worship

The Bishop has established a Phase 1, 2, and 3 plan for churches to return to in-person worship. After looking at the options and requirements, and after listening to the Administrative Council, I have decided that it would be in our best interest to wait until Phase 3 before opening the doors to in-person worship. Phase 1 began May 24th. Phase 2 will begin based on the progress of Phase 1. And Phase 3 will be determined based on the progress of Phase 2. I am asking you all to be patient a little while longer. I am looking forward to seeing everyone in our sanctuary as much as you are. But all things considered, I believe our best option is to wait until we have safer conditions. If it takes much longer than expected to move to Phase 3, I may reconsider opening at Phase 2. But for now, we will wait for Phase 3.

There will be some United Methodist churches willing to be "Pioneer" churches that will open sooner. Under strict protocol they will be a test run to determine when other churches can open their doors. Some churches may decide to try "Drive-in" worship. But I feel it is better to wait until we have safer conditions before we can whole-heartedly celebrate together in worship. It will be a great celebration when that time comes. In the meantime, we will continue to offer on-line worship.

The Administrative Board has formed a Healthy Church Team to help prepare us for a return to in-person worship. They will oversee the cleaning and transitioning guidelines established by the Bishop. The church building will be thoroughly cleaned and ready for our return. In the meantime, social distancing and face coverings will be required for any essential meetings held in the building (i.e. Administrative Board, SPR, Trustees, Finance, etc.)

As I receive updates from our Bishop about the progress of these phases, I will keep you informed. It's important to know that the Bishop will determine the dates of each of these phases. It may or may not line up with our Governor's plan.

Continue to pray for the end of this pandemic. Be calm in the midst of the chaos. Meanwhile, be ready to celebrate our return from "exile". It will be an exciting time.






