The Visitor



I don't know what got into me, but for Memorial Day this year I was up at 5:45 and decided to go for a walk. I was out the door by 6:30 and was about a mile into my walk when the devil crossed the path in front of me. Well it wasn't the devil but it

was a 100+ pound dog whose breed will remain nameless. He walked out of a group of trees and down into the ditch after he cast a brief glance my way. I wondered for a minute, should I stop...turn around ...or keep going, what was that dog going to do? He had stopped down in the ditch he has just entered and was now giving me the full glare as I continued toward him. I knew he was debating what to do and I was praying he would let me pass and stay in that ditch (the ditch is pretty deep maybe 10 feet down, so I was hoping I wasn't worth the effort.) As I drew even with him, I heard the deep bark that said, I am coming to cause you grief and I saw him begin to rush up the side of the ditch. I knew that if that dog got out of that ditch I was in trouble, so I spun and rushed to the edge of the ditch right above the charging dog, I hit the top of the ditch, slammed my foot on the edge of the path and letting out my own deepest bark, I wanted him to believe I was coming over and down upon him and it worked, as the dog performed a perfect summersault on the side of the ditch and was 180 off in the other direction, he was 100 yards away before he looked back to see if I was still chasing him. Crisis averted and I continued on my way, thankful I possessed the high ground in the event that had just occurred it made a huge difference.

It wasn't a roaring lion, but as close to one as I ever hope to get and it reminded me of the scripture from I Peter 5:8 – Like a roaring lion your adversary the devil prowls around looking for someone to devour. Resist him!! It got me to thinking while I continued, how do we resist the devil? I then remembered a passage from Genesis when God was speaking to Cain. God said, "Sin is crouching at the door, its desire is for you...you must master it." We must resist by aggressive means!! We must be aware of the danger and meet it head on, full force, allow no room in your life for sin to reside. If I hadn't met that dog on the trail with 100% full force, I think I would have teeth marks on me today. If you don't confront a sinful situation with your full attention it will leave a mark on you. The devil does not want your full attention! Just keep going and that I won't bother you ..much. Just keep allowing sinful thoughts to circle the edge of your mind, it won't tangle you up in something worse. The devil knows if we are distracted or slightly open to a situation, he will continue his attack. Additionally, Satan allows our own pride to take over and that sin will take root in our hearts and man is it hard to get out. James chapter 4: 1-10 is a great read about this, Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners and purify your hearts, you double minded. You must master sin and send it running, or it will control you.

The high ground is ours as God will support us in our fight. Don't let sin lurk around, it will bite you. Attack it and send it running off, and may God bless you...real good!
