PARENT / STUDENT HANDBOOK ADDENDUM

HANDBOOK UPDATES AS OF 8/21/2019:

IX.E.2. (p. 23) Revision: Students who bring cell phones or other electronic devices to school must check in their devices with their home room teachers before morning assembly. Phones can be retrieved after school from their teacher or after-school-care supervisor.

IV.E. Absence & Tardy Policy (pp. 11-12)

Addition: Students absent from school more than twenty (20) days during the year will not be promoted to the next grade level until they have taken an entry assessment to determine the level of their academic ability.

Ten times tardy will be recorded as one absence and factored into the total absences for the year.

X.E. Disciplinary Infractions Point System (Grades 5-8)

Revision/Addition: Disciplinary infractions will be tallied on a twelve (12) point system. Every students begin the year with zero (0) points. Each infraction results in the accumulation of one or more points. Smaller infractions count as one (1) point. Moderate infractions count as two (2) points and serious infractions count as three (3) points. If a student accumulates six (6) points during the school year, he/she will be suspended for one day. If a student accumulates nine (9) points, he/she will be suspended from school for two day. If a student accumulates twelve (12) points, he/she is suspended for three days and may only be conditionally readmitted to *Pope John Paul II Academy*. Any further disciplinary infractions result in expulsion for the rest of the school year. When suspended, a student automatically receive permanent 0% grades (F) in all classes for the day(s) suspended and will not be allowed to make up the work for credit.
