



REACH

REACH is a program where volunteers help and mentor one student in grades K-5. Volunteers read with their student and provide homework assistance, helping to build their self-confidence along with their reading skills.

Many of our students are Hispanic, and have difficulty at school because they are not able to fully understand and/or complete their homework assignments. Due to language and educational barriers, their parents are not able to help. The children benefit from having a mentor to help them with homework, and just being their friend. Groups of mentors and students meet weekly for one hour and a staff member supervises and facilitates every session. Teens are welcome to volunteer and earn community service hours!

During school breaks we also offer mini-camps and other enrichment activities to help children keep up with their language skills.
