- **3. Zoning:** Zoning inspectors meeting is tonight. Finished plot work at Schumacher land. Also working with surveyor 7824 Tallmadge road property splitting. Permit for a new porch. Message with Agricultural building being built, fielding zoning phone calls.
- 4. **Fiscal Officer**: Bill asked if trustees were aware of the issue with an indigent burial. They had not all heard. Tim expressed the brother and sister in law came forward and wanted the cremains. Since the State approved the cremation and burial, Bill told Kevin his view seemed they would need to go through legal channels to exhume the cremains. Father initially involved, but then wanted no involvement in costs for cremation and was the only relative funeral home/State heard from. Bill stated they would be responsible for the cost. He stated he had gotten a grant to pay for the cremation for the funeral home, however township paid for the plot and burial as required by law for the indigent. involved. Tim agreed they would have to pay. But they could pay for a headstone if they wanted a more formal marker. Will present this to the family. Trustees in agreement. Jeffrey asked some questions regarding some checks that were missing in a series of warrants. Bill said it was simply a printing error and the checks will be voided as they were never used. If he forgot to remove from the printer and then prints agenda on them as example. That's why the report says skipped warrants.
