General Prerequisites

The following are prerequisites common to all Rescue 3 instructor courses. Additional prerequisites are required for each specific class.

- 1. Current EMT, Paramedic, Wilderness First Responder, or other pre-approved medical certification
- 2. Recommendation letter from an active, independent Rescue 3 Instructor
- 3. Either complete a teaching methodology course or have validated teaching experience from a recognized training organization
- 4. Complete the Medical Application for Instructor School
- 5. Be in good physical condition and free of chronic medical conditions
- 6. Have strong swimming ability (for instructors teaching water courses only)
- 7. Submit a resume to Rescue 3's corporate office
