To: Congregational Treasurers

January 31 is the Fiscal Year End for the Synod. The budget passed by the Assembly in 2017 for the fiscal year ending January 31, 2019, called for mission support from congregations in the amount of \$2,405,000 or \$200,417 per month. As of November 30, 2018, we have received \$1,895,310 which is an average of \$189,530 per month. If this trend continues for December and January, the Synod will be approximately \$130,000 short in meeting our budgeted expenditures. To meet our goals for 2018/2019, **we need your help.**

If your congregation is behind in your commitment for mission support, we would be grateful if you could catch up before our year ends. If your congregation is current with mission support we thank you and ask if there is any way that you can contribute anything above and beyond your commitment it would be greatly appreciated.

The Synod Council, the Officers and Staff give thanks for all the support the Synod has received and continues to receive from you.

We pray that all is well with your congregation and your financial support from your members.
