Chief's Summary

2015 marked my first year as Fire Chief. I had some big shoes to fill following the 28 exceptional years of service Ralph Wardrope has provided as Chief. The continuing support of the membership has made this challenging job highly enjoyable.

Calls for service in 2015 were less than 2014 due to a change in our Medical Emergency Protocols. Although even with this change, we still responded to 169 calls for service – 125 of these calls were mutual aid calls. This shows how much we, as a fire service, rely on our neighbors to provide our communities with the best service. 110 of these calls were during weekdays between the hours of 6am and 6pm, and we are still dealing with lower attendance during these daytime calls (avg. 4.8 per call).

We have invested 1,950 hours in training and 1,480 hours in call response. In total, the members have invested 3,900 volunteer hours in trying to make Milford and our surrounding communities a safer place. That is 162 days or five and a half months' worth of time volunteered.

2015 was the first year the physical fitness test became a semiannual requirement. All the members required to take the test this year passed. I am very proud to say I am the Chief of a department which puts an emphasis on physical fitness and performance.

We are always maintaining and training with our equipment to help us perform our jobs safer and faster. We are adding equipment to help us better serve our customers. We have added more rope rescue equipment to allow us to serve a niche in East Hants, to further help Milford and surrounding communities.

A sign that hangs in our station reads "Being a volunteer is no excuse for mediocrity"; I believe the members of the Milford & District Volunteer Fire Department embody this statement completely. The level of dedication these 21 individuals exhibit to make our communities safer is an example of genuine good will and professionalism.
