Production Classes:

Class #63: Production Pair

(Two offspring from the same sire or the same dam. Each group is evaluated on the parent's ability to pass on positive traits to their offspring. In the event that the 2 llamas are full siblings, the owner must choose either sire or dam to represent the group. You cannot obtain points for both.)

Best in Show Awards

(Each judge will present a Best in Show Male and Best in Show Female. Non-Breeder Champions will compete with their corresponding sex.)
