WHAT IS THE FIRST ROBOTICS COMPETITION?

- FIRST- "For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology" <u>www.firstinspires.org</u>
- Students work with teachers, adult mentors, and engineers to design, build and test a competition ready robot in a grueling six week building period.
- The competition is an exciting, sports inspired game that requires a combination of skill and strategy to be successful.
- The game involves operating a 120-pound robot using radio control to navigate the court and score points against opponents.

- The members of the HHH ThunderColts attend both Half Hollow Hills High School East and West. Each year, the team gains a stronger presence in the HHH community and this year they excelled Not only did the team become an Alliance Captain, they also won the Quality Award at the Central New York Regional and they were the WINNERS of the SBPLI Regional competition 2 which was held at Hofstra University. The team will now advance to the National Championships to be held in Detroit in April 2019.

THE GOALS OF THE THUNDERCOLTS ARE:

- To continue motivating our local high school students to explore exciting new technology, learn critical technical and business skills, while promoting the field of engineering through entering a variety of competitions.
- To inspire young adults to pursue careers in STEM; careers that are important in the 21st century.
- To create opportunities for students interested in art, business, communications, finance and more.
- To introduce a unique program that combines the excitement of sport with the rigors of STEM. Each year, as part of the program, students apply their knowledge of Science, Math and Technology to Engineer a complex machine for competition against local, national and international teams in various robotic challenges.

WHY DO WE NEED SPONSORS?

- Our team runs like a small business.
