On Thursday, June 15, 2017 at approximately 3:58pm, Wyckoff officers were dispatched to a home on Carriage Lane for a report of a 93 year old male located in a swimming pool, unresponsive and not breathing. It was further reported that the male could not be removed from the water. Chief David Murphy and Officer William Christopher arrived on scene and observed the male in the water being held at the edge by a neighbor. The two officers pulled him from the pool and confirmed him to be in cardiac arrest. Sergeant Michael DeMaio and Officer Ryan Noon then administered an AED and began CPR. Wyckoff Volunteer Ambulance Corp and Valley Hospital ALS arrived on scene and assisted with patient care. The male was ultimately transported to the hospital. Detective Sergeant Joseph Soto and Detective Sergeant Michael Ragucci assisted. The police department would also like to thank two members of the Wyckoff Volunteer Fire Department for their assistance as well.
