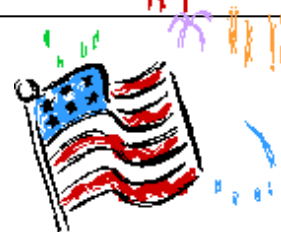

## Lunch & Nutrition

One of our responsibilities as an accredited child care center is to make sure that children's nutritional needs are being met while they are in our care. Our accrediting agency requires us to follow USDA nutritional guidelines. To help us meet this requirement, parents should send in milk (or another source of dairy) each day with lunch. If you do not want your child to have dairy, please provide documentation (due to allergies, religious or other health reasons). If you do not send in milk, please provide water or 100% fruit juice. (All children must have a drink.) Thank you!

## Policy Reminders/Updates

Vacation Policy - Full tuition is due each week of the school year, regardless of whether or not your child is in attendance. The only exceptions to full tuition are school "vacation weeks" (Thanksgiving, Winter & Spring break weeks) and summer. Half tuition will be due if your child is absent for an entire school "vacation week."

Drop-Off - Please bring your child to his/her classroom at drop-off each day. **Parents may NOT leave their child in the hallway** in the morning as teachers may not always know they have arrived, and we need to keep accurate attendance at all times.

## Medications/Sick Policy



If your child is taking medication of any kind (allergy meds, antibiotics, cough medicine, Tylenol, etc.), *please inform the office*. It is not a problem to be taking medication and attend school; however, we need to know what their symptoms are, what side effects the medicines may have, and we also need to keep track of contagious illnesses in the school. Thank you for your cooperation with this very important health policy.
