Saturday, January 14, 2012 is also the date that we have our County AZGOP Meeting which most of our PC's will be eligible to attend. Because of the County Bylaws, only PC's elected or submitted before the middle of November 2011for appointment can have a vote at the 2012County Meeting. We want to have as close to 100% attendance of our eligible membership. If you cannot attend the meeting, only another person **from your precinct** can carry your proxy. Usually this is another PC in your precinct. The Area Directors will be contacting the precinct captains to make sure that everyone is represented either in person or by proxy at this meeting. If your precinct does not have a captain, the Area Directors will appoint a captain.

Saturday, January 28, 2012 will be the State AZGOP Mandatory Meeting. Only the State Committeemen elected at the LD 8 Organizational Meeting in November of 2010 are eligible to vote. If a State Committeeman cannot attend he or she can have another State Committeeman carry their proxy. The proxy carrier does not have to be a PC in their precinct, but must be an elected State Committeeman from LD 8.

The County and State Party will be mailing the "Calls" (Invitations) to these meetings in early January. So check your mailbox and be sure to come. Our delegations to these two meetings will be some of the largest and because of that our votes will definitely be a deciding factor in any contested elections.

SECOND VICE CHAIRMAN - BOE JAMES

Last year I said that for the immediate future, we would be concentrating on candidates for election in 2012 since there will be both primary and general elections in 2012. That will still be the emphasis this year until after the election.

We will start the New Year off with a joint appearance of four Legislators who represent us in the U.S. Congress and the AZ State Capitol. Although each of the four is up for re-election this year, they will speak to us as elected legislators rather than as candidates. Congressman David Schweikert, State Senator Michele Reagan, and State Representatives Michelle Ugenti and John Kavangh will talk to us about their plans and predictions for the coming year, then listen and answer questions. If you e-mail your questions to me at ro james@yahoo.com in advance, I will give them to the candidates and they might answer them during their

initial talks. Other questions will be asked after their presentations, as time permits. I expect that all four will arrive early and meet and greet in the lobby. This should be a very informative and interesting meeting. I expect that other candidates will be present to meet and greet and collect petition signatures in the lobby. The meeting will once again be held at our normal meeting "home" in the Mustang Library. Although District business related to PC's is a primary purpose, attendees need not be PC's to attend. I encourage you to invite your politically aware neighbors to come hear the legislators and candidates themselves. Bring a friend or two to each meeting if you can.
