



# Admission Updates

- Regular Decision deadline moved to January 1st
- SAT/ACT Writing is Optional but Recommended
- Self-Reporting of Test Scores via Common Application
  - Applicants must submit official test scores from testing agency before decision release
- New Pathway Programs
  - Regents Engineering Pathway Program (REPP)
  - Georgia Tech Arts & Sciences Pathway Program
    - 2<sup>nd</sup> year admission to College of Design, Ivan Allen College of Liberal Arts, and College of Science Degree Programs


- Founded in 1913

Annual research awards of \$101 million received in fiscal year 2015 exceeded the \$100 million milestone – a first in the university's history.






Federal sponsorship, accounting for more than 70% of the total research volume, grew by 21%.







### Move On When Ready (MOWR)

- Consider:
  - What course credit will you receive?
  - Are you pursing the recommended rigor in your course of study?
  - How does your "dream school" consider Dual Enrollment courses vs. AP Courses?
- MOWR Students will still apply under Freshman Admission



### **FAFSA and Financial Aid**

- FAFSA available October 1st
  - Requires prior year (2015) tax information
  - IRS Data Retrieval Tool populates form

  - Info on HOPE and Zell Miller Scholarships
- Some colleges may require institutional forms or CSS Profile



### Standardized Testing

#### SAT Update:

- No penalty for wrong answers
- More relevant content
- Optional, evidence based writing section
- Concordance to pre-March 2016 SAT scores & to ACT scores available online
- Free tutoring via Khan Academy

#### ACT Update:

- Writing remains optional
- Writing score scale changing from 1-36 to 2-12



# Regents' Engineering Pathway Program

## "To encourage and accommodate students who desire to study engineering"

- Complete required courses at a partnering institution
- Apply to 1 or more of the 5 engineering programs
  - Georgia Tech, Georgia Southern, Kennesaw State,
     Mercer University, and University of Georgia
  - Each institution has separate admission requirements, required courses, and admission processes
