Historic Building Plaque Program Order Form

The Westbrook Historical Society's plaque program for buildings over 100 years old raises awareness of Westbrook's many historic buildings.

The plaque is an 11" x 18" oval with black lettering. It is made from a composite material that has a white surface and a black core that shows when carved. It will not rot or warp. The oval plaque is designed with a carved silhouette of clipper ship, "David Crockett," captained by Westbrook's Joseph W. Spencer. Generally, there are two lines of text. The first line is the name of the first property owner. The second line is the date. Circa (c) is used if the specific year is estimated. If the owner's occupation is known, it can be inserted between the name and the date.

The Historical Society will be happy to share its research with and to work with each property owner if desired.

We will limit our production schedule to a certain amount each year. Each applicant will be placed in order of application date. We will call to you to let you know when the research and production of your plaque will begin. Estimated production time is 6 weeks. Prior to beginning work, we ask that a donation of \$200.00, payable to the "Westbrook Historical Society, Inc." be mailed to the address below.
