Ending school bubbles and isolation will be dangerous, says UNISON

Education secretary Gavin Williamson has said he expects school bubbles to be removed in England if Covid restrictions are lifted on 19 July.

In response, UNISON head of education Jon Richards said:

"Removing school bubbles and halting self-isolation will lead to more disruption, not less.

"Coronavirus cases in schools are at their highest levels since February because the government has scaled back safety measures.
