The forum will be conducted in an open house format and interested individuals are welcome to attend anytime between the hours of 5:30–6:30 p.m. The draft court layout and related exhibits will be displayed and there will be an opportunity to ask questions, exchange information and offer suggestions regarding the plan with City Staff and raSmith our engineering consultant.
