DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing short hunting recurve in excellent condition. This is an American Archery (AA) 54" Super Nitro design, but with a slightly different mix of tropical hardwoods in the riser. This bow was made for Larry Nirk archery; Nirk archery was located in Idaho. It was most famous for its nocks, but contracted with Martin and American to supply bows to which Nirk attached its logo and sold under the Nirk brand name. When you examine and hold this bow, you will readily see and feel its high quality. This bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Model decal is in excellent condition, the AA logo is an added reproduction as the Nirk silk screen came off when I partially refinished the limb. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was priced the same as the Bear Grizzly, but is a better performer (I have owned several of each). The draw weight has been verified. I put this bow to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours) to make sure the old glues still held and no stress lines developed.

Comes with a good string and nocking point.
