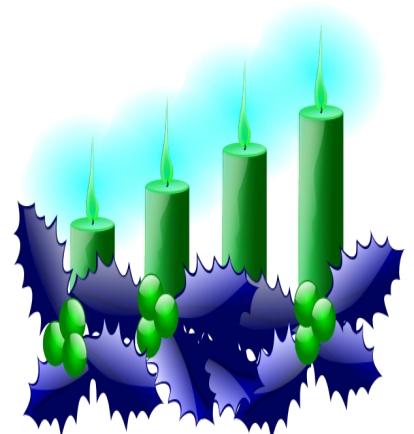
Advent Candle Lighting

Cards and stamps are supplied and the list of volunteers is included in a notebook as part of the Family Service bag. Members volunteer for one month.

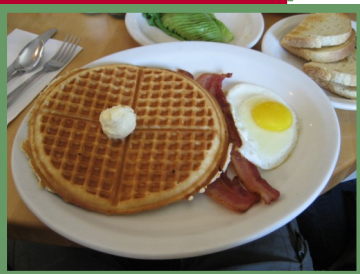

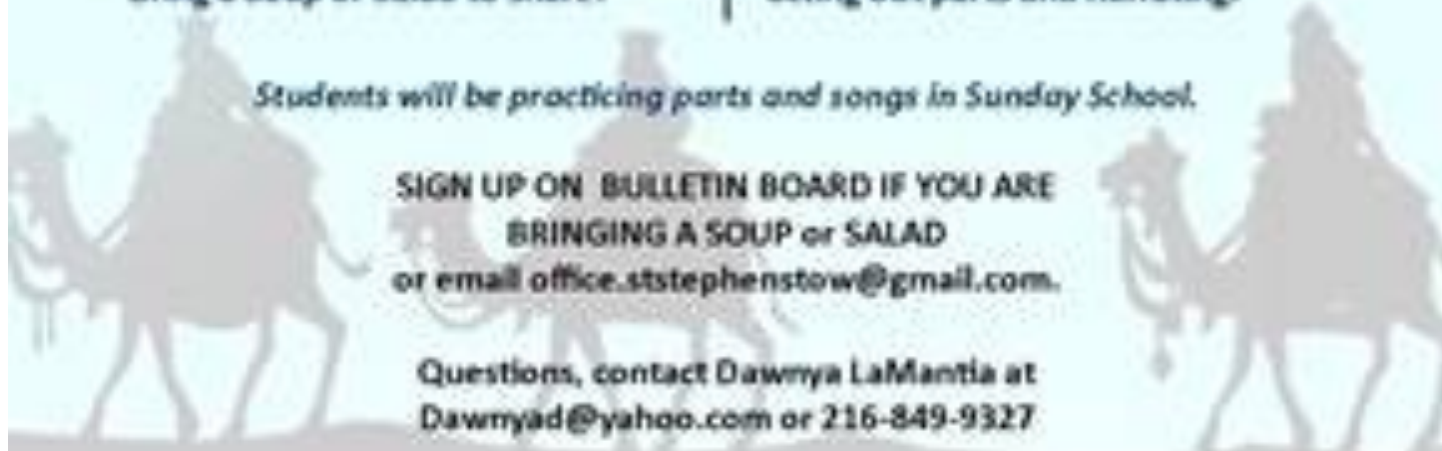

Opening:

Michelle Amato opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes:

The October meeting minutes were reviewed and approved. Sandee Davis made a motion to accept the minutes and Gary Reynolds seconded. Motion approved.

Financial Report:

Sherry Petrosky asked about the line item Mission Support on the designated report and its use.

It was suggested that the Community Benevolence line item be used for Family Promise.

Jane Koch sent all the financial reports electronically to be reviewed. It was mentioned that the Contribution Summary report headings should be changed to read Monthly Total (MTTD) not Year to Date. (YTD Total) Sherry Petrosky made the motion to accept the October Financial Report and Gary Reynolds seconded. Motion approved.

Pastor's Report:

Pastor John sent his monthly report electronically for review the day before the meeting.

Old Business:

Ray Rousseau reported that a new Music Committee was created by Pastor John as a result of Pam Hickey's resignation. We are in need an organist. The committee members are: Dawn Horner , Ellen Wingate, Connie Wilson, Georgia Brooker, Pastor John and Ray Rousseau. The committee discussed changes in the music, which should appeal to all generations in the church. Compensation for the organist will be discussed at a later date.

New Business:

The final review of the 2019 budget presented and approved by all. The Congregational Meeting is November 18th with luncheon before the meeting. Michelle Amato and Jane Koch will present the budget.

A motion was made to adjourn. Sandee Davis made the motion to accept and Ray Rousseau seconded. Motion approved.

St. Stephen Lutheran Church
Congregational Meeting
November 18, 2018

Opening Prayer: Michelle Amato, Council Chairperson

Michelle Amato opened the meeting and introduced Bill Choler, Finance Committee spokesperson, to explain how the 2019 Budget was determined. He presented the current Finance Committee: Jane Hecht, Anjalee Wagers, Dani Schlea and Mike Yaquinto (absent).

Bill reported that all the expenses over the last few years were reviewed and the fixed expenses were evaluated. Benevolence seemed to be misunderstood and many questions were asked. The Mission Support appropriation for 2019 is \$23,000, with \$20,000 going to Synod and \$2,300 to St Stephen Mission Support. Council has the authority to decide where the Mission Support money should be used in our church.

Discussion followed regarding giving to the Synod and not to the church. Synod giving would be honored. There were comments about the Memorial Funds and how they would be handled. Bill explained the money would be placed in the designated memorial account and be held for a certain time period. The family would then be contacted, and if the money wasn't designated, the Council would decide which account to deposit it. Designated accounts are tracked monthly and will be part of future budget discussion.

The amount of \$290,000 estimated giving was questioned since only \$156,000 was pledged. Bill explained that in past years, members who have not pledged have usually given a substantial amount.

A question was asked if the church Bylaws required 10% giving to the Synod. Jane Koch, Council Financial Liaison, said she would check. If more money was collected for Synod appropriation, who was going to decide what to do with the money? Bill stated that the Council would look at the account and make the decision. The Synod receives an estimated amount for 2019 giving from St. Stephen to plan their budget.

Kim Clark thanked everyone for all their hard work. Bob Dieter asked about the increase in Jane Hecht's salary, if more hours were required, and why the cut in the Witness and Service salary. Jane Koch explained that Jane Hecht will have more responsibility and will work the necessary hours to complete the work. The position of Witness and Service will now be a part-time position.

A motion was made to accept the 2019 Budget, with the heading change Synod Appropriation to Synod Support, and was approved by majority. The 2019 Budget was approved.

A motion was made by Bob Dieter to adjourn and Scott Schlea seconded. Motion approved.

Michelle Amato closed with prayer.
