Remember all ranges are closed on May 20th until around 3:00 pm.


In June we will be hosting the Mid-Atlantic Multi-Gun Championship and all ranges are closed from noon



Back in the day, companies and businesses stayed away from hot-button political issues. After all, why risk alienating customers by weighing in on controversial issues? But no more ... at least when it comes to the Second Amendment. Since the shootings at a high school in Parkland, Florida in February, a host of companies have taken a stand on the Second Amendment – and none of them are favorable. Consider this:

• Two weeks after the shootings, Dick's Sporting Goods announced that it would end the sale of assault weapons at its 35 Field & Stream locations, which specialize in hunting and outdoors products. (The chain had already ended such sales at its Dick's-branded stores after the Newtown, Connecticut school shootings in 2012.) The CEO of Dick's also announced that he favors a nationwide ban on assault weapons. Then, to pander even more to the anti-gun crowd, the chain said it plans to destroy the "assault-style rifles" it recently banned from its stores, rather than return them to distributors and manufacturers.

• Delta Airlines and United Airlines canceled an agreement.....

**Orientations** Orientations, where we tour the grounds and discuss rules and features of the club are mandatory for prospective members, and interesting for existing members. The next three for 2018 will be: Sunday, May 6th at 1:00 pm, Sunday, June 3rd at 1:00 pm, and Saturday, July 7th at

1:00 pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. We meet in the upper floor of the clubhouse.

**Club Championship** The Club Championship will be held July 22nd at 9:00 am. Think Youth Field Day shooting events for adults. We will shoot 4 events that day: One 25 bird round of trap, 25 clay birds at 25 yards with an iron sighted revolver or semi-auto pistol, 25 clay birds at 50 yards offhand with an iron sighted or scoped rifle, and 25 clay birds at 30 yard with a hunting class long, recurve or compound bow. No crossbows, magnification, or electronics on bows please. You use your own firearms, ammo, bow and arrows. The Club Champion will be the person with the highest cumulative score. You may shoot less than the four events. The fee is \$20. To pre-register send a check for \$20 made to "York Izaak Walton" to Howard C. Thompson 53 N Main St. Stewartstown PA 17363 or bring cash or check to any meeting and give it to Howard or Gary. Contact me with questions.
