

Your sins are forgiven in the name of + Jesus Christ.







The barren has borne seven, but she who has many children is forlorn." The LORD kills and brings to life; he brings down to Sheol and raises up. 7The rich; brings LORD makes poor and makes he low, he 8He raises up the poor from the dust; he lifts the needy from the ash heap, to make them sit with princes and inherit a seat of honor. For the pillars of the earth are the LORD's, and on them he has set the world." 9"He will guard the feet of his faithful ones, but the wicked shall be cut off in darkness; for not by might does one prevail." 10The LORD! 
hear our prayer.

Listen as we call on you, O God, and enfold in your loving arms all for whom we pray, in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord.




