## 2019 Summer Reading Guide

1. Summer Reading at the Giles County Public Library is a program with two components: weekly events to attend and opportunities for readers to read, record their books, and earn prizes.

Parents/guardians are highly encouraged to pre-register their child for the Summer Reading Program.

2. Readers will write down the titles of books completed in their <u>Summer Reading Personal Passport</u> provided by the library.

\*Personal Passports are for the Summer Reading Child Participants, but both
ADULT and TEEN Passports are also available!

\*\*EVERY PARTICIPANT MUST HAVE A PERSONAL PASSPORT TO PARTICIPATE IN SUMMER READING!\*\*

- 3. Completing 1 Children's Book or 25 pages of a chapter book will count as ONE book for logging purposes.
- 4. Upon turning in their Passports once per week, children (12 and under) qualify for three prize opportunities.
- a. Weekly Prize every child who participates in the Summer Reading Program will receive a weekly prize for their reading.
- b. <u>Door Prize</u> if the child reads 3 or more books per week, he or she may enter their name into a drawing for a door prize.

  The drawings will be held once a week.
  - c. <u>Tickets for the Universe of Stories Fair!</u> every time a child reads and logs one book, they will receive ONE ticket towards games and activities at the end of Summer Reading, during the Universe of Stories Fair! at the First National Bank.
  - 5. At the conclusion of the Summer Reading Program, the library will hold a special event,
    the <u>Universe of Stories Fair!</u> open to anyone who has read books and/or attended events.
    \*\*Children MUST hand in their Personal Passports at this event to receive their tickets for games!\*\*
