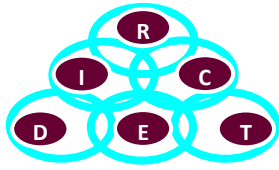

ACTIVITIES OF Centre DIRECT

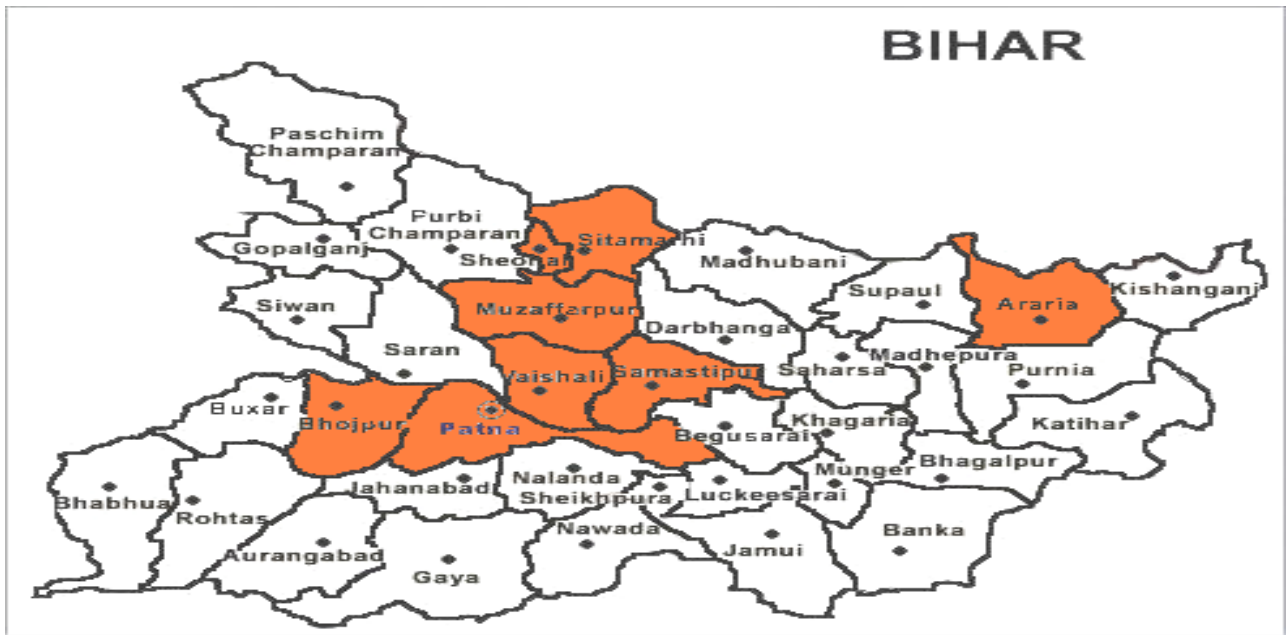
Focus on awareness raising sensitizing the community, capacity building, developing and disseminating education, training, advocacy issues related with women, adolescent & youth through SHGs
