- All Grocery-Getter vehicles must come to the track RACE READY. All glass, headlights, & taillights should be removed along with other excess parts like spare jack, spare tires, old parts, trash, etc. Interior must remain in stock condition, 4 & 6-cylinder cars, SUV's & minivans are eligible with a maximum of 22 feet in length. No 4wd unless driveshaft removed making it 2wd. No Trucks. Stock fuel tanks. The ONLY added reinforcements eligible (but not required) are an outside bar or plate to the driver's door. No roll cages. Must remove airbags. Can remove the catalytic converter but must fully replace with pipe. Must have a muffler. THIS IS NOT A RACE CAR!!!
- Drivers must wear long-sleeves & long pants (fire suit recommended). Neck collar is required. Helmet must meet or exceed the 2010 SA Snell or SFI 31.2 or SFI 24.1 (youth) standard and be worn at ALL TIMES on track.
