it's not every year that the Feast of the Transfiguration falls on a Sunday, so in most years, most people tend to let it pass them by if they are not in the good habit of attending daily Mass. The Transfiguration of the Lord is meant to be a foretaste of heaven. It was meant to be a consolation to the weary eyes and hearts of some of the apostles who may have grown a bit weary after many months of ministry with varying success. Jesus was transfigured before them and took on a heavenly glow, and was proclaimed by the Father as His Beloved Son. For the Apostles who witnessed this event, it would have been a reawakening, and a realization that this was the truth of Heaven...this is what Heaven would be like.
