Dear Mr. NESHEK:

The WisDOT has approved the eligibility of ARROW-CRETE CONSTRUCTION, LLC for DBE credit on USDOT federally-funded projects performing a commercially-useful function in the area(s) of:

- Concrete slip form and handwork (curbs & gutters, paving, driveways, sidewalks, colored stamped and base); Inlets and manholes; Joint sawing and sealing; Retaining walls; Trucking; Sodding and seeding; Excavation; Grading; Concrete breaking, cutting and removal

The USDOT requires North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes be used to describe the type of work a firm can perform for DBE credit. We have assigned the following NAICS code(s) to your firm's certified work area(s):

- 237110 Water and Sewer Line and Related Structures Construction
 - 237310 Highway, Street, and Bridge Construction
 - 238110 Poured Concrete Foundation and Structure Contractors
 - 238910 Site Preparation Contractors
 - 238990 All Other Specialty Trade Contractors
 - 484220 Specialized Freight (except Used Goods) Trucking, Local
 - 561730 Landscaping Services

The DBE Program uses the SBA size standards for NAICS codes as required by the DBE program's federal regulation, 49 Code of Federal Regulation parts 23 and 26. Please note that DBE crediting is subject to the WisDOT's discretion.

WisDOT is a member of the Wisconsin Unified Certification Program (UCP), which is made up of four certifying agencies: City of Madison, Dane County, Milwaukee County and WisDOT. As a certified DBE firm of the Wisconsin UCP, you are eligible to bid as a DBE on USDOT-funded projects let by any of the four agencies.

For record-keeping purposes WisDOT is counting ARROW-CRETE CONSTRUCTION, LLC as a Native American-Owned Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (NADBE).

If your firm should develop the resources, including equipment and personnel to perform a commercially-useful function in other work areas, you may apply for an expansion of your company's DBE certification. Your firm must be approved for an expansion of certification before we will approve any DBE credit for work performed in any work areas other than those listed in this Approval of DBE Certification letter.

This approval decision is based upon information provided to WisDOT as part of the application for certification as a DBE. Should this information change, you must inform our office in writing within 30 days of the change. Your failure to notify our office within 30 days could result in you being found to have failed to cooperate with the WisDOT and for your firm to be decertified. Also, if your firm is found to have concealed or misrepresented information you provided to the WisDOT, your firm will be subject to decertification.

This certification of eligibility is effective 3/31/2014. Please note, however, that you are required to submit an Annual No-Change Affidavit declaring that your firm continues to meet DBE program eligibility standards.

Management of your firm's certification status will now be performed through the Wisconsin UCP's Civil Rights Compliance System (CRCS). Each year, you must review your firm's Company Profile in CRCS and renew it in the system. Also, you will be required to electronically sign a No-Change Affidavit statement annually and provide the company's most recent federal tax return.

You should check with WisDOT staff to learn your firm's CRCS account information such as the user ID, logon password and signature password. Additional information about CRCS can be found at the WisDOT DBE website at www.dot.wi.gov/business/engrserv/dbe-main.htm
